Each year, Camberwell Girls Grammar School offers Academic and Music Scholarships for entry to Years 5, 7, 9 & 11. Current CGGS students are also eligible to apply.

Scholarships are awarded on the basis of the Scholarship Examination results, latest school reports, NAPLAN test results and an interview with the Principal. In addition, Music candidates complete the Music & Audition Form, provide music certificates and will be advised of the date and time of their Music Audition.

Scholarship Conditions

- Scholarships are to remain confidential.
- Candidates are required to hold an Australian or New Zealand Birth Certificate, or Australian Citizenship Certificate or Permanent Resident visa.
- Candidates are to be in the appropriate year level for entry.
- Scholarships are applicable to tuition fees only and do not cover the registration fee, enrolment confirmation fee, composite fee, private music lessons, school uniforms or textbooks, which are the responsibility of parents.
- Scholarship holders are expected to remain at CGGS for the duration of their scholarship.
- Scholarship holders are expected to participate fully in school life and in the case of Music Scholarship holders, the co-curricular music program of the School.
- No student may hold more than one scholarship.
- A student who holds a scholarship is not eligible to receive a further sibling discount. However, in the case of subsequent enrolments, the sibling discount will apply to siblings provided they attend concurrently.

Year 5 Scholarships are tenable for Years 5 and 6, Year 7 Scholarships are tenable for 6 years; Year 9 tenable for 4 years and Year 11 tenable for 2 years.

The Year 5 Scholarship Examination will be held at the Junior Campus, 4 Mont Albert Road, Canterbury at 8.30 am to 11.00 am. Parents are to collect their daughter promptly at 11.00 am. Candidates are required to bring a bottle of water and a snack for morning tea.

Years 7, 9 & 11 Scholarship Examinations will be held at the Senior Campus, 2 Torrington Street, Canterbury at 8.30 am to 12.00 noon. Parents are to collect their daughter promptly at 12.00 noon. Candidates are to bring a bottle of water and a snack for morning tea.

Music Scholarships

Music Scholarships are awarded at Years 5, 7, 9 & 11. Candidates will be notified of the date and time of their Music Audition. Please see Audition Requirements. Candidates of Brass and Double Reed instruments are particularly invited to apply. Candidates will have achieved the following AMEB standards or equivalent in other authorities:
