MUSIC AUDITION REQUIREMENTS

Music candidates will receive an email with their audition date and time and the venue for all year levels will be the Senior Campus, which is located at 2 Torrington Street, Canterbury. A warm-up room will be available for her use approximately 20 minutes before the scheduled audition time.

All Music candidates are required to apply online and complete the Academic Scholarship Examination, provide academic documentation see check list and in support complete the Music & Audition Form together with:

- AMEB Certificates and Reports and optional report from music tutor
- Passport-sized photo for the Music Department

Candidates will be required to perform the following

- a given short sight reading excerpt
- a selection of aural tests appropriate to the level of study
- a selection of technical examples in scales, arpeggios or technical exercise which demonstrate facility, control, coordination and tonal qualities. These examples nominated by the candidate should be in at least 3 different key tonalities including major and minor.
- **it is the candidate's responsibility to provide an accompanist as necessary**

Audition performed on one instrument:

- Two contrasting pieces in style and tempo no longer than 8 minutes in total.

Audition(s) performed on two instruments:

- Two pieces on the main instrument and 1 short piece or excerpt on the second instrument. (Candidates may be requested to begin at a significant section or conclude early).
- Total performance time to be no longer than 10 minutes.
- A short sight reading excerpt.
- A selection of aural tests appropriate to the level of study.
- A selection of technical work i.e. scales, arpeggios or technical exercises, which demonstrate facility, control, co-ordination and tonal qualities.
- These examples are to be nominated in at least three different key tonalities including major and minor.
- It is the candidate's responsibility to provide an accompanist as necessary.

Note: Aural testing will not necessarily be based on AMEB type examples.

At the beginning of the audition candidates are requested to provide a written summary containing the titles of pieces and the technical 'set' of keys (if applicable) that are currently in preparation for practice/performance.
